- Working Group formed on April 16, 2015
- To develop recommendations for permitting interstate movement of poultry and eggs from a HPAI Control Area.
 - Including frequency of surveillance testing
 - Number of tests per premises
 - Biosecurity procedures
- Recommendation document finalized May 20, and approved by NA.

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- Intention to create the document
 - Reference for SAHO for use during HPAI event
 - Basic uniform permitting recommendations
- Intention not to create
 - State requirements
 - Rewrite the Secure Poultry Supply Plans
- Do not replace or supersede existing requirements of receiving state.

- 1. Delay moving live poultry & hatching eggs until commercial poultry have been tested.
- 2. States avoid placing additional restrictions.
- 3. Traceability information is required.
- Flock has normal flock production parameters as described in the Secure Poultry Supply (SPS) Plans.

- 5. Follow Truck & Driver and Product Specific biosecurity procedures as described in the SPS Plans.
- 6. Premises of origin is not an Infected, Suspect or Contact Premises.
- Hatching and table eggs follow the 2-day holding procedure as described in the SPS Plans.

- Testing minimum of two 11-bird negative
 AI PCR pools per house.
 - One pool is 11 dead/sick birds per 50 dead in a house.
 - Collect all pools within 24 hours prior to move or

Collect one pool within 48 hours prior to move and 2nd pool within 24 hours prior to move.
