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Frame System Objectives

MY FRAME

- CV format enables the user to store their course records, experiences, specialties, and profile information.
- Track progress toward fulfilling recommended courses for an assigned role or future career role.
- Support user mobility across organizations in response to an event or over their career progression
- Registration form enables quick entry into the Frame system

COURSE CATALOG


- Access to training aligned by recommended skills for their role
- Flexible Structure
 - Organizations can start with a base framework scaffold and customize positions and course recommendations
 - e.g. Incident Command Structure for Animal Frame, Competencies Grid for One Health
- Organizations can add volunteers or users that may or may not be in an existing LMS
- Support for upload of just-in-time training courses


- Identification of training progress and gaps by individual, agency, or system wide


Animal Emergency Frame



Workshop Overview:

THEMES

- Food incident vs. Food Emergency
 - The skills needed are the same, but the emergency scenarios differ in severity, scale, and the number of stakeholders involved.
- System Requirements
 - Users need to be able to cross or be seen by other agencies
 - Additional mechanisms to inactivate users, update courses, and allow users to choose a role for their development
- Benefits of the Frame
 - Ability to track both coursework and experience
 - Ability to utilize Frame for professional development
 - Determine gaps in training before an event
 - Ability to add volunteers/users outside of the agency system
 - Approval of coursework by a supervisor or administrator
 - Customization of roles and courses by agency
 - Courses span technical, emergency management, and professional skills

NEEDS

- Feedback on the Food Emergency Frame structure
 - Functional roles
 - Technical skill groups
 - Catalog and align courses to positions
- Approval and alignment of the standard recommended courses
- Beta testers!
