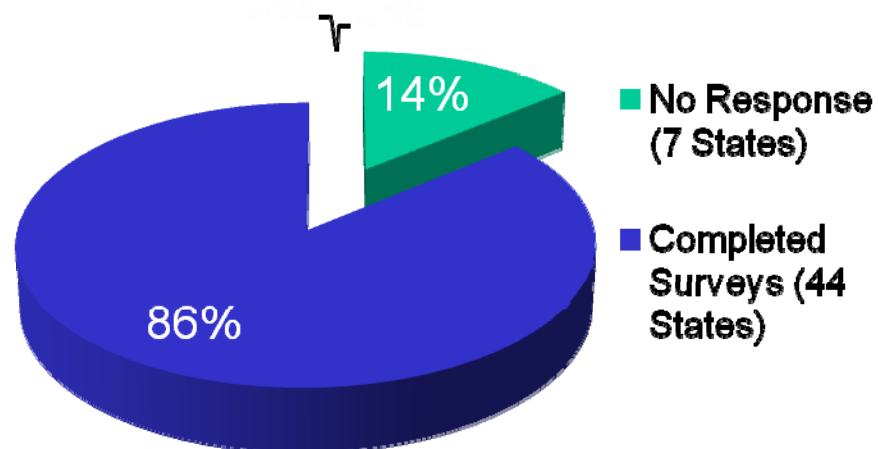

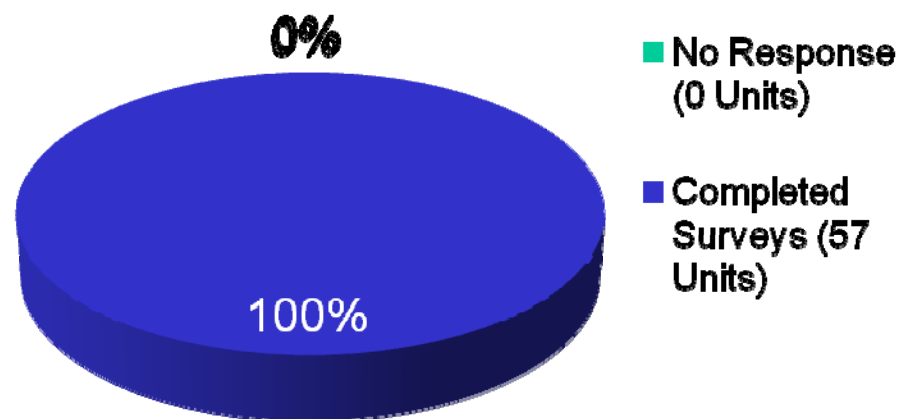


Response Rate for State and Federal Units

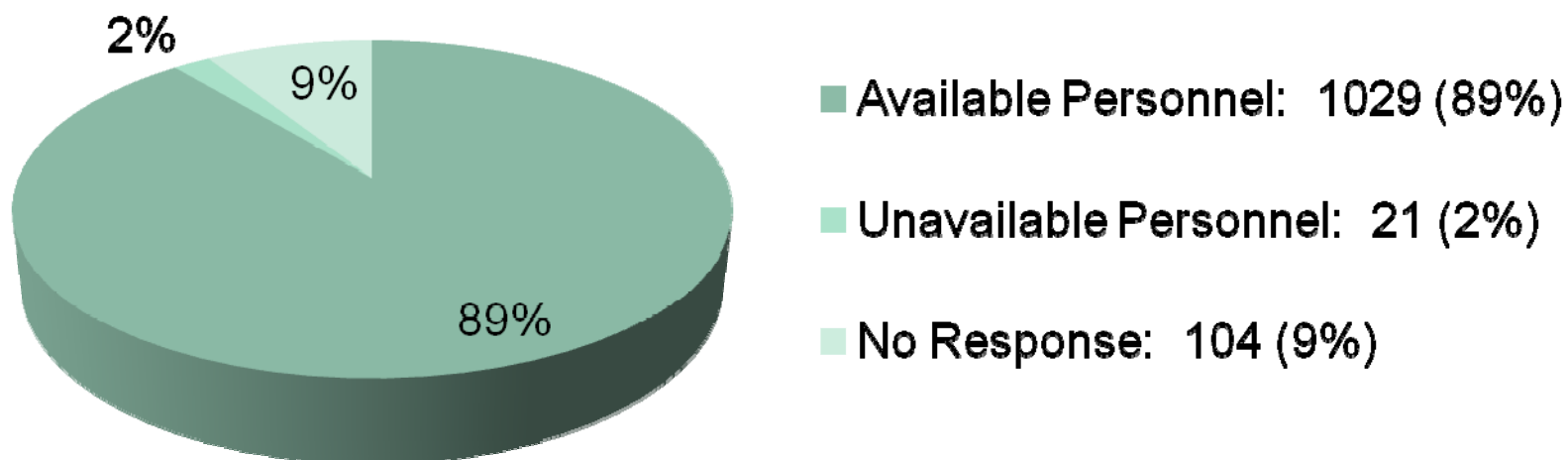

Total Agriculturally Employed State Personnel: 1154*

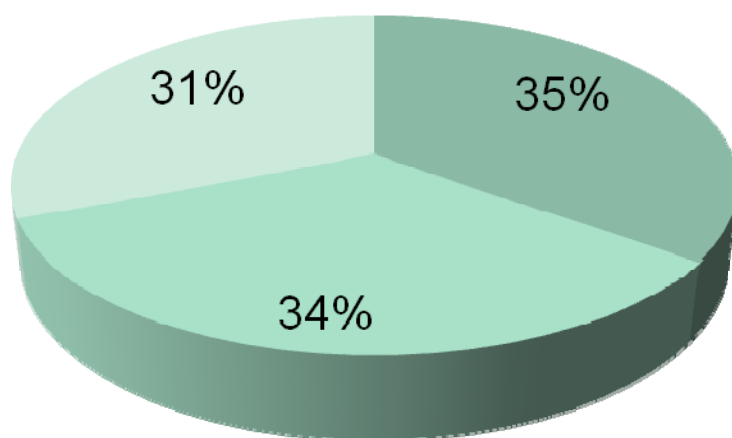

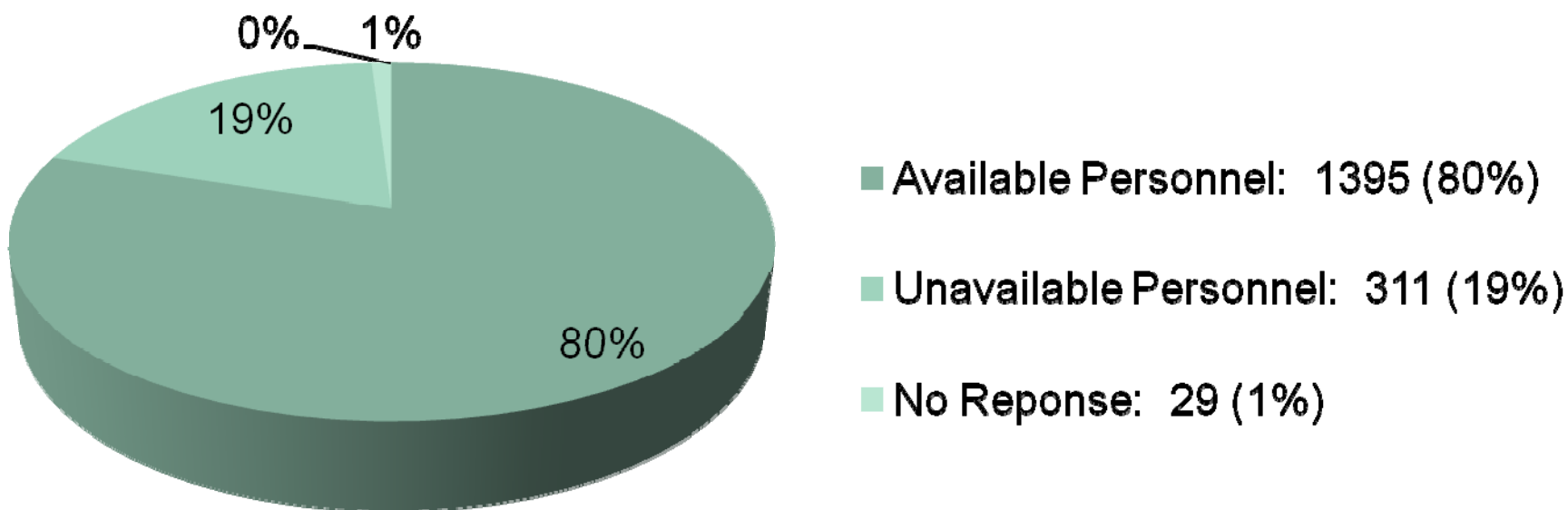

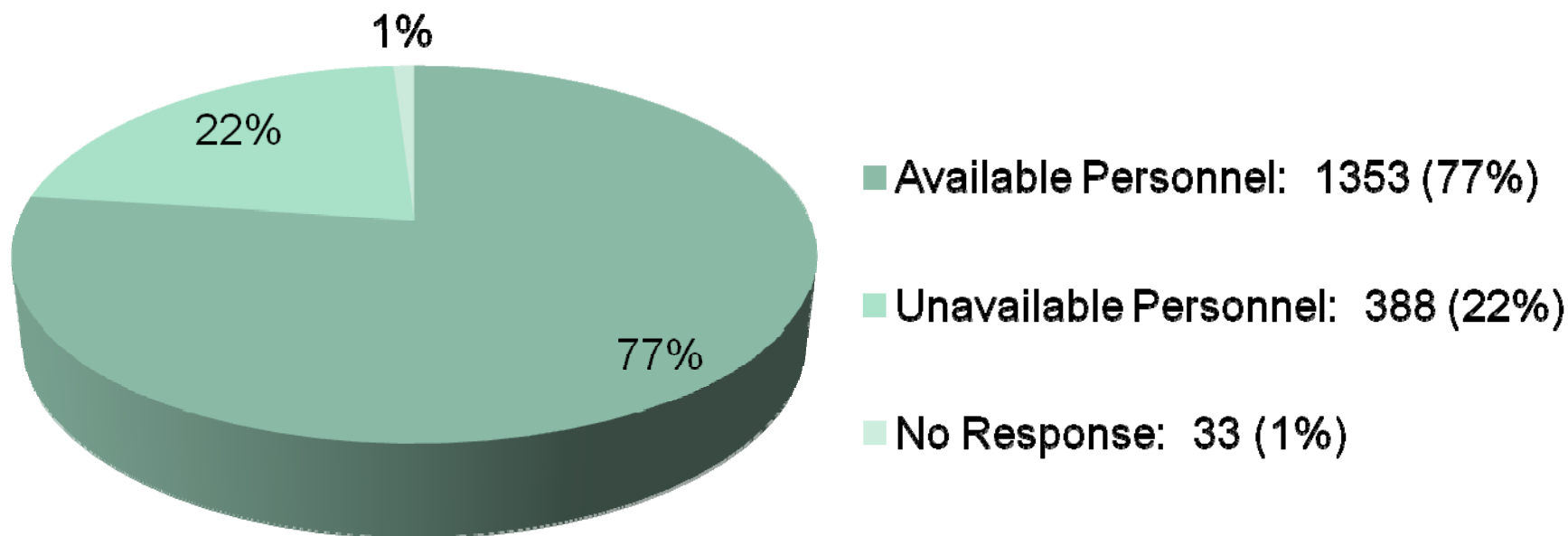

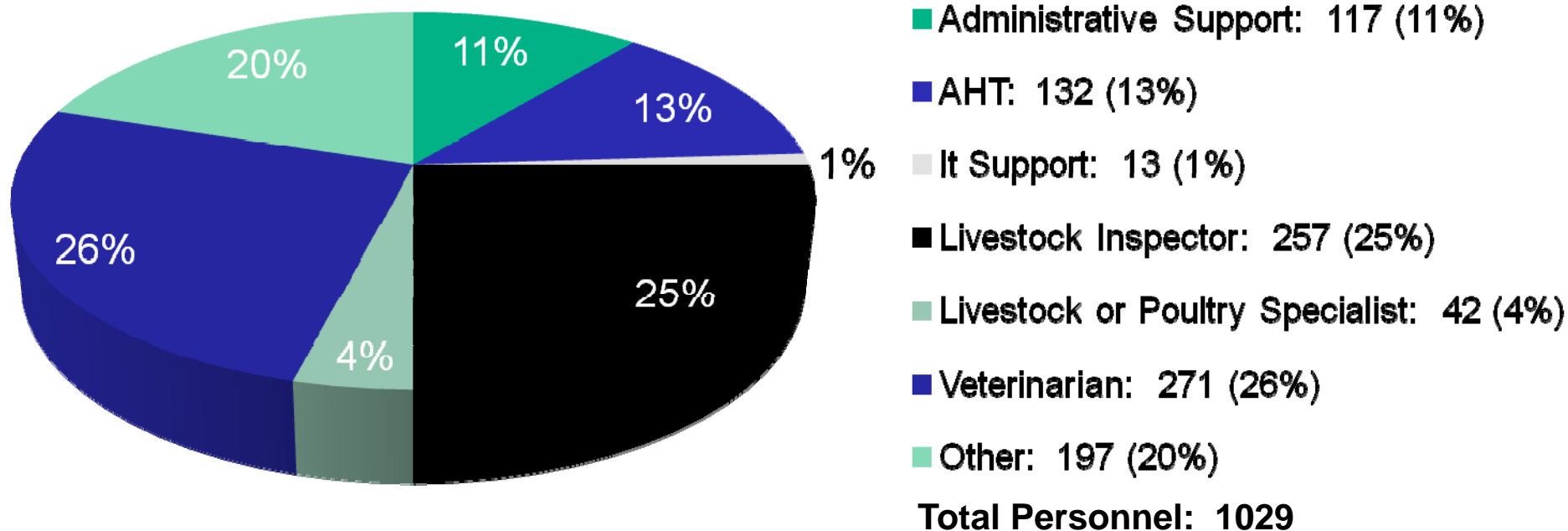

State Personnel Available for In-State Deployment by Professional Category

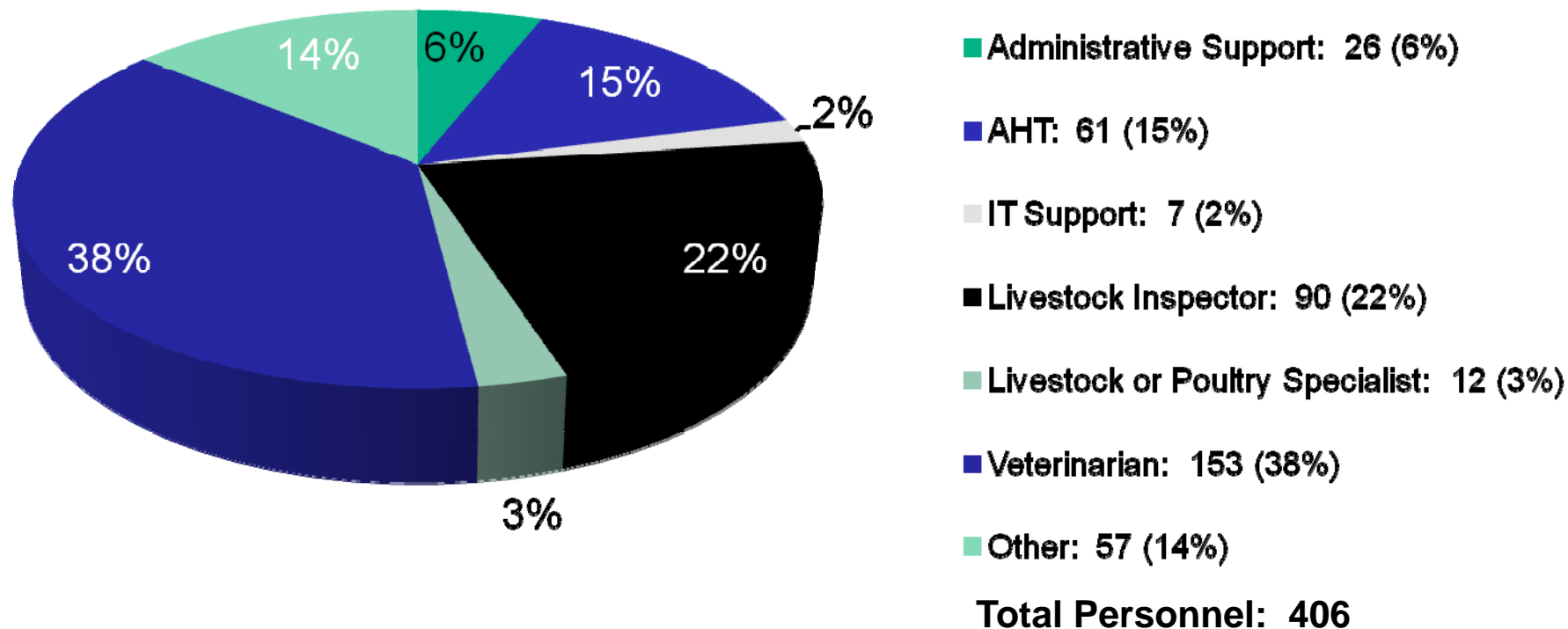

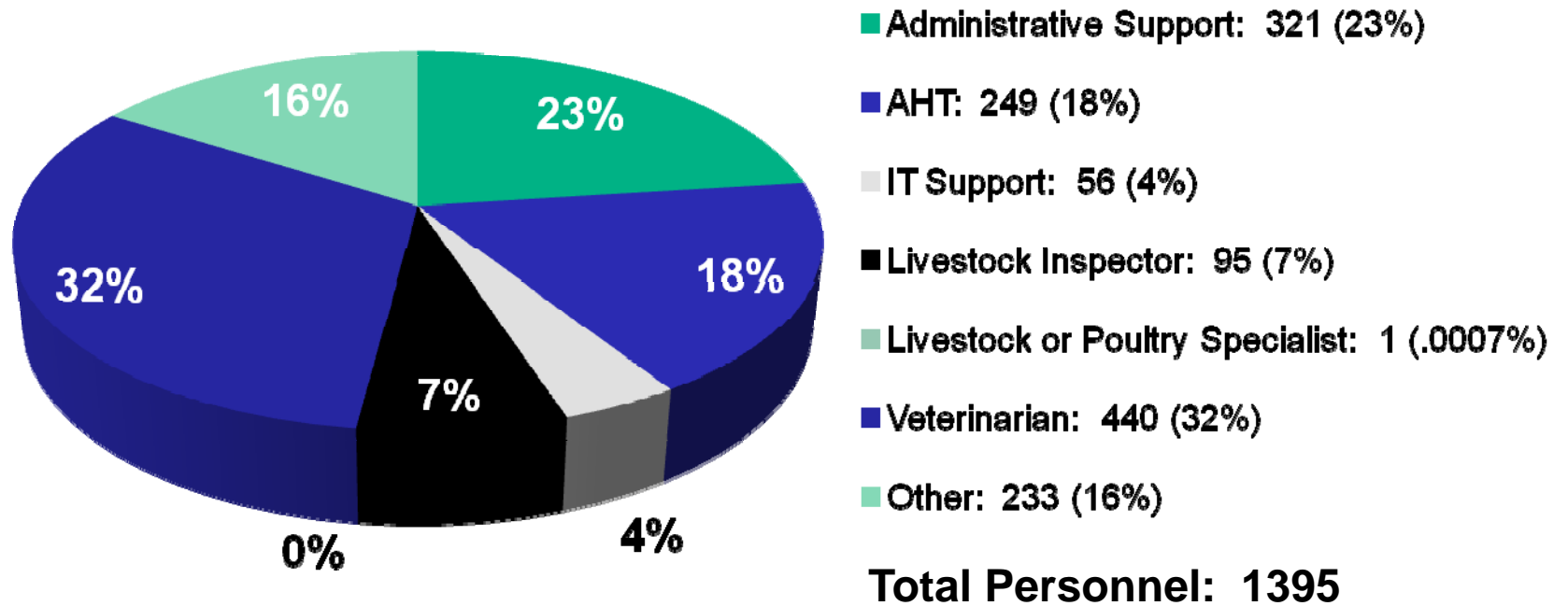

Federal Personnel Available for In-State Deployment by Professional Category

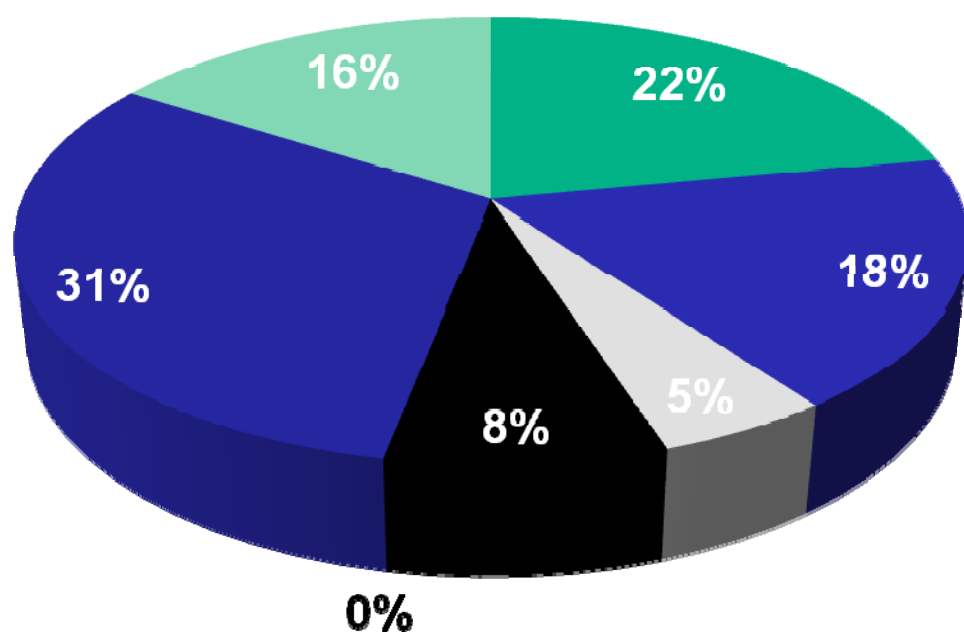

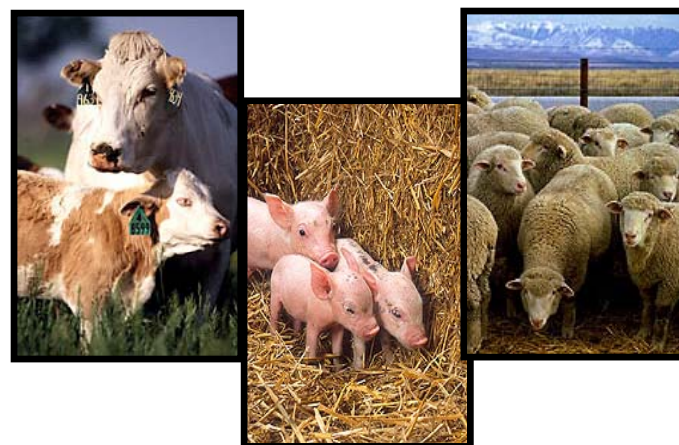
